Ans- This system removes the waste materials from body.

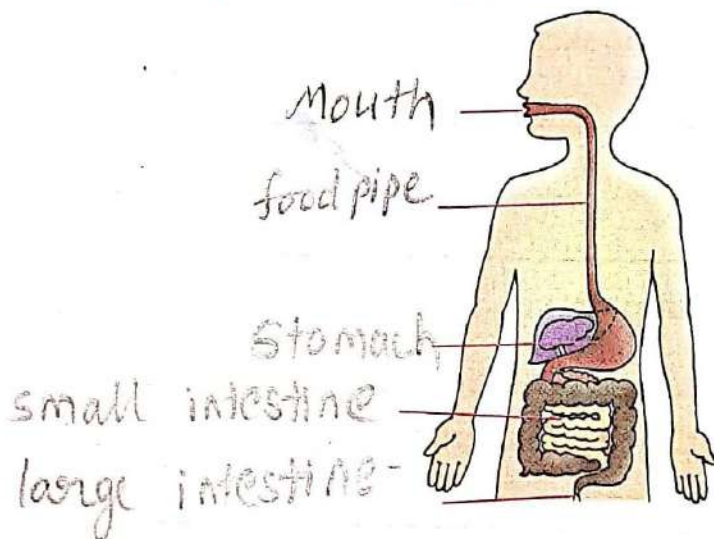
