Chapter_ 13.(Present Tense)

The present tense refers to present time _ now , or the time of speaking or writing. General facts or things that are always true are also be expressed in the present tense.

- 1. Simple present 1. base form of the verb + s/es for singular subjects example_ Satish reads a magazine.
- 2. Base form of the verb for plural subjects and the singular pronoun I and you. Example_ The monkeys **play** in the jungle.

I **live** in Mumbai.

- 2. Present Continuous_ is/am/are+ing form of the main verb. Example_ Rancho is **running** on the beach.
- 3. Present perfect _ has / have + past participle of the main verb. Example_ Sudeep has failed in the exam.
- 4. Present perfect continuous_ has / have+been + ing form of the main verb. Example_ Zohra has been practising yoga for many years.
