Chapter_ 15 (Future Tense)

The future tense is a verb form that describes an action or event that has not happened yet, but is expected to happen. Future tense is marked by the use of the auxiliary **will** or **shall**.

The future tense has four forms.

1. Simple future_ **Will/shall** +base form of the verb.

Example_ I **will dance** at the party tomorrow.

2. Future continuous_ **will/shall+be +ing+ base form of the verb.**

Example_ I **will be dancing** at the party tomorrow.

They **will be sending** the letter tomorrow.

3. Future perfect _ **will + have** + past participle of the verb

Example_ Sanjay **will have completed** his course by 2014.

They **will have reached Chandigarh** before your programme.

4. Future perfect continuous_ **will+ have+been + ing form of the verb.**

Example_ Suraj **will have been watering** the plants when his daughter leaves for school.

Ram **will have been leaning** music for five years next week.
