GRAMMAR CHAPTER_4 (NOUNS)

:- Nouns are the names of people, things, substances, places, ideas and feelings.

Example_ Ritesh, computer, salt, park, friendship, victory.

Main types of Nouns:-

1. Proper Noun
2. Common Nouns
3. Countable Nouns
4. Uncountable Nouns
5. Concrete Nouns
6. Abstract Nouns

Description:-

1. Proper Noun:- Proper Nouns are the names of specific people, places or institutions.

Example_ Kanika, Indore, Delhi public school etc.

Exercise 1. Identify the proper Nouns and rewrite them with Proper capitalization.

2. Common Nouns:- A Common Nouns is the common name of all the things in a class.

Example_ monkey, fan, lake, football etc.

3. Countable Nouns:- Countable Nouns are those which have singular and plural forms. They can be preceded by number and quantity words.

Example_ Countable Nouns

Singular.	Plural.
bottle	bottles
teacher	teachers
woman	women
baby	babies
mountain	mountains

4. Uncountable Nouns:- Uncountable Nouns are nouns which don't have plural form, and cannot be used with number words.

Example_ Uncountable Nouns_

music. Plural not possible

furniture _

health_

gold_

bread_

5. Concrete Nouns:- Concrete Nouns are the names of physical phenomena which can be observed with the senses.

Example_ student, water, bus, furniture, train etc.

6. Abstract Nouns:- Abstract Nouns are the names of phenomena that are not physical, and that we can only think about and not observe with the senses.

Example_ happiness, size, friendship, childhood, imagination etc.
